Education and scholarship award guidelines

1. Available to all graduating high school seniors, regardless of course of study, or to members of James E. Coffey Post #3, James E. Coffey Unit #3, or James E. Coffey Post Sons of the American Legion Squadron #3 in good standing.
2. Students must have a grade point average “C” or better. Applicants must show evidence of acceptance for further education by a recognized educational institution or college.
3. Shall be the son, grandson, daughter, granddaughter, step-child, or spouse of a current member in good standing for at least three (3) consecutive years, or of a deceased Post #3 Legion, Auxiliary, or Sons of the Legion member, who was a member in good standing of one of the above organizations, at the time of his or her death.
4. If applying under a deceased member, proof of membership at the time of death must be submitted with the application.
5. Application dates:
 - (A) Submitted to committee **no later than April 15th**.
 - (B) Committee recommendation to be submitted at May’s post meeting.
 - (C) Awarded by Post Commander or representative at awards night for high school, or at a post function.
6. Scholarship application forms are available from the James E. Coffey post or from your guidance counselor.
7. The James E. Coffey post #3 scholarship(s) will be for a minimum of \$500.00.

4. High school seniors need to submit a transcript of high school grades.
5. At least two (2) letters of endorsement.
